Copy of the letter No.1/7/98-3FPPC/6884, from Govt. of Punjab Deptt. of Finance (Finance Pension Policy and Co-ordination Branch) to all Heads of the Departments etc. etc.

Sub: Implementation of recommendations of the IVth Punjab Pay Commission regarding Pension and other retirement benefits – Rationalization of Pension of pre 1996 pensioners/family pensioners.

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In continuation of Finance Department letter No.1/7/98-1FP3/8709 dated the 16th July 1998 and letter No.1/7/98-1FP3/8825 dated the 21st July/18th August, 1998, on the subject mentioned above, I am directed to state that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that w.e.f. 1.1.1996 pension of all pensioners irrespective of their date of retirement shall not be less than 50% of the minimum pay in the revised scale of pay introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 of the post last held by the pensioner. However, the existing provisions in the rules governing qualifying service and minimum pension shall continue to be operative. Similarly, w.e.f. 1.1.1996, family pension shall not be less than 30% of the minimum pay in the revised scale introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 of the post last held by the pensioner/deceased Government employee. Pension and family pension will be revised/consolidated w.e.f. 1.1.1996 in the manner indicated in the succeeding paragraphs:-

1. Floor ceiling of pension/family pension in respect of Government employees retired/died in harness on or after 1.1.1996:-

"Pension shall continue to be calculated in terms of above referred communication at 50% of the average emoluments in all cases and shall be subject to a minimum of Rs.1310 per month and a maximum of up to 50% of the highest pay applicable in the State Government, which is 23,600/- per month since 1st January, 1996, but the full pension in no case shall be less than 50% of the minimum of the revised scale of pay introduced with effect from 1st January, 1996 for the post last held by the employee at the time of his retirement. However such pension will be suitably reduced pro-rata, where the pensioner has less than the maximum required service for full pension as per the rule applicable to the pensioner as on the date of his/hier superannuation/retirement and in no case it will be less than Rs.1310/- p.m.,"

However, in cases where the pension consolidated is treated as the final full pension, it shall not be less than 50% of the minimum of the revised scale of pay introduced with effect

from 1st January, 1996 for the post last held by the pensioner at the time of his retirement. Such pension will be suitably reduced pro-rata, where the pensioner has less than the maximum required service for full pension as per the rule applicable to the pensioner as on the date of his/her superannuation/retirement and in no case it will be less than Rs.1310/- p.m. Similarly, in cases where the family pension so consolidated in terms of above referred communication is treated as final, it shall not be less than 30% of the minimum of the revised scale of pay introduced with effect from 1st January, 1996 for the post last held by the concerned pensioner/deceased Government servant.

2. Floor and Upper ceiling of pension in respect of Government

employees retired from service between 1.1.1986 and 31.12.1995:-

In respect of Government employees retired from service between 1.1.1986 and 31.12.1995 the basic pension already consolidated w.e.f. 1.1.1996 in terms of Finance Department letter No.1/7/98-1FPIII/8825 dated the 21st July, 1998/18th August, 1998 shall not be less than 50% of the minimum of the pay scale introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 for the post last held by the pensioner. However, the same may be reduced pro-rata where the pensioner has less than the maximum required service for full pension as per rules in force at the time of retirement and in no case it will be less than Rs.1310/- p.m. The upper ceiling of pension consolidated under these orders will be 50% of the highest pay of Punjab as already clarified in above said communication.

3. Revision/consolidation of family pension at normal rate in respect of Government employees died while in service or retired between 1.1.1986 and 31.12.1995:-

The basic family pension of such pensioners has already been allowed to be consolidated in terms of Finance Department letter No.1/7/98-1FPIII/8825 dated the 21st July, 1998/18th August, 1998 in which dearness relief up to CPI 1510 (i.e. @ 148%, 111% or 96%) I.R.I. & II and 40% of basic family pension was merged.

Now the difference, if any, between the 30% of last pay drawn and the basic family pension authorized at the time of death/retirement is to be added in the above said consolidated family pension but this basic family pension shall not be less than 30% of minimum of the pay scale introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 for the post last held by the pensioner/deceased Government employee. The floor ceiling of family pension consolidated under these orders will be Rs.1310/- per month w.e.f. 1.1.1996.

4. Revision of enhanced family pension (if necessary) in respect of those who retired or died while in service between 1.1.1986 and 31.12.1995:-

The grant of enhanced family pension shall be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in Finance Department letter No.1/7/98-1FPIII/8709 dated the 16th July, 1998.

5. Floor ceiling of pension/family pension in respect of Government employees retired/died while in service prior to 1.1.1986:-

In respect of the Government employees retired prior to 1.1.1986 the basic pension already revised/consolidated w.e.f. 1.1.1996 in terms of Finance Department letter No.1/7/98-1FPIII/8825 dated the 21st July, 1998/18th August, 1998 shall not be less than 50% of the minimum of the revised scale of pay introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 for the post last held by the concerned pensioner. However, the same may be reduced pro-rata where the pensioner has less than the maximum required service for full pension as per rules in force applicable to the pensioner at the time of retirement and in no case it will be less than Rs.1310/- per month. The pension shall be treated as basic pension for the purpose of future grant of dearness relief on pension.

Similarly, the basic family pension already consolidated in terms of above said letter dated the 21st July/18th August, 1998 and 2nd August, 2000 shall not be less than 30% of the minimum of the revised scale of pay introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 for the post last held by the concerned pensioner/deceased Government employee who died while in service prior to 1.1.1986 and in no case it will be less than Rs.1310/- per month.

It is no unlikely that the arrears due in some cases, may be calculated incorrectly leading to payment that might have to be recovered subsequently even after this exercise. The pension disbursing authorities should, therefore, make it clear to the pensioners/family pensioners while drawing arrear that the payments are being made subject to adjustments from amounts that may be due to them, if any discrepancy is noticed later. For this purpose an undertaking should also be obtained in writing from every pensioner/family pensioner at the time of drawal of arrears of pension/family pension consolidated/revised under these orders.

In case where the family pensioner was alive as on 1.1.1996 and died subsequently, his/her legal heir is/are also entitled life time arrears w.e.f. 1.1.1996 till the death of pensioner. For this purpose legal heir may also apply to the Head of Office/Department.

6. Responsibility of Head of Office/Department and other Authorities:-

It shall be the responsibility of Head of Office/Department from which the Government employee had retired or was working last before his death to revise the pension/family pension and to issue revised Pension Payment Authority in respect of Government employees retired or died while in service during the period from 1.1.1986 to 31.12.1995. The concerned Head of Office will accept the application (in duplicate) for the revision/consolidation of pension/family pension of those who retired/died while in service between 1.1.1986 and 31.12.1995. An acknowledgement in respect of receipt of application with

date may be given to the applicant. It will be the responsibility of Head of Office/Head of Department to revise/consolidate the pension/family pension under these orders. He will send to the Accountant General Punjab one copy of the application of the pensioner along with relevant record, calculation sheet of pension/family pension, copy of the order of the pay scale admissible to the deceased Government employee/pensioner under Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1998 for the post last held by him/her, record of qualifying service etc. Where it is not possible to arrive at a conclusion regarding admissibility of pay scale introduced w.e.f. 1.1.1996 for the post last held by the pensioner/deceased Government employee, the final decision can be taken in consultation with the Finance Department.

In no case pensioner/family pensioner will be asked to surrender his/her original PPO for issuing revised authority. His authority will be issued by the Accountant General Punjab under the existing PPO number and would travel to the Pension Disbursing Authority through the same channel through which the original PPO had traveled. The Pension Disbursing Authority would affix this authority to both halves of PPO.

7. Option for Pensioner/Family Pensioner:-

Each pensioner/family pensioner who is entitled for the benefit of revision of pension/family pension in terms of these orders is required to apply for revision of the same in prescribed form in duplicate as at Annexure/I along with photocopy of PPO to his/her Head of Office/Department within a period of 180 days (i.e. up to Feb., 2006) from the date of issue of these orders. Those who fail to submit their application during the stipulated period will be deemed to have opted to continue to draw their existing pension/family pension. However, in exceptional cases where the Head of Department considers that delay in submission of application for revision of pension/family pension was beyond the control of the applicant, such delay in submission of the application will be condoned only with the approval of Finance Department.

8. Interpretation:-

If any question arises relating to the interpretation of any of the provisions in these orders, it shall be referred to the Finance Department for decision.

9. Residuary Provision:-

In the event of any general or special circumstances which is not covered under these orders or about which certain inconsistency are noticed, the matter shall be referred to the Finance Department and the Finance Department will prescribe the conditions to be followed under such circumstances. Such conditions as prescribe by the Finance Department under this paragraph shall be deemed to be part of these orders. Further if the Government is satisfied that there is a requirement to prescribe certain additional conditions, the Government shall prescribe such additional conditions as prescribed by the Government under this para shall be deemed to be the part of these orders.

Copy of the letter No.3/81/05-3FPPC/6944 Dated 30.8.05 from Govt. of Punjab, Department of Finance (Finance Pension Policy and Co-ordination Branch) to all Heads of the Departments etc. etc.

Sub: Eligibility of divorced/widowed daughter for grant of family pension.

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that as per provision contained in para No.4.3(i) of Punjab Govt. letter No.1/7/98-1FPIII/8709 dt.16.7.98, son/daughter including divorced/widowed daughter is eligible for the grant of family pension till he/she attained the age of 25 years or upto the date of his/her marriage/remarriage or till he/she starts earning his/her livelihood, whichever is earlier, son/daughter including widowed/divorced daughter shall be deemed to be earning his/her livelihood if his/her income is Rs.2620/- per mensem or more Further as per provisions of Punjab CSR Vol.II in Rule 6.17 (4) ©, the disabled daughter is already eligible for family pension for life, on the fulfillment of specified conditions mentioned in Punjab Govt. letter No.1/10/99-3FPPC/302 dt. the 10th January, 2002.

Keeping in view the decision of Govt. of India contained in their O.M.No.1/19/03-P&PW(E) dated 25.8.2004, the matter has been considered and it has now been decided that there will be no age restriction in the case of the divorced/widowed daughter who shall be eligible for family pension even after their attaining 25 years of age subject to all other conditions prescribed in the case of son/daughter. Such daughter including disabled

divorced/widowed daughter shall however, not be required to come back to her parental home as stipulated in para 2(ii) of this department letter No.1/10/99-3FPPC/302 dated the 10th January, 2002, which may be deemed to have been modified to that extent.

3. The relevant provisions of the Punjab CSR Vol.II may be deemed to have been amended to the extent of the contents of this letter, and a notification for the same will be issued in due course.




