

Subject: Rationalization of Pension of those pensioners who retired during the period from 1.1.86 to 30.9.1986.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to Punjab Govt. letter No. 1/7/98-1FPIII/3325 dated 21.7.1998/18 Aug. 1998 and to State that the State Govt. has been receiving representations from those pensioners who retired during the period from 1.1.86 to 30.9.86 pointing out that they were getting pension at lower rate than that admissible to the employees who retired prior to 1.1.86 as their notional pay has been fixed by taking into account the notional increase of 10% of the basic pay in the existing scale as in the case of those employees who were in position on 1.1.86 whereas they have not been given this increase for part of the period prior to 1.1.86. Sh. A.N. Sharma and others have filed a Civil Writ Petition No. 4913 of 2002 in the Punjab and Haryana High Court also. The Hon'ble High Court has passed the following order on the said writ petition:

"After hearing counsel for the petitioners and having gone through the Writ Petition, we dispose off the same with a direction to the Respondent to consider the representation filed by the Petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order."

2.- On careful consideration of the representation and the instructions issued by the Govt. the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that in case of those employees who retired or died during the period from 1.1.86 to 30.9.86, the period falling within 10 months preceding the date of retirement, during which pay was drawn in pre-revised pay scales, the emoluments, for the months for which pay was drawn in the pre-revised pay scales shall be calculated after taking into account the following:-

- (i) For the period during which pay is drawn in pre-revised scales.
 - (a) Basic Pay, Personal Pay, if any, Special Pay including IPA, plus actual

ad hoc D.A. admissible up to CPI 603 in the un-revised scales and I.R. (Interim Relief), if any.

(b) Notional increase on the basic pay by applying the fitment benefit of 10% on the basic pay in pre-revised pay scales subject to a minimum of Rs. 50/-, and

ii) For the period during which pay is drawn in the revised scales.

Basic Pay, Personal Pay, if any, and Special Pay including WPA in the revised scale.

3.- The emoluments of preceding 10 months will thereafter be calculated by adding (i) and (ii) and dividing the result by 10. Notional Pension admissible will consequently be 50% of the average emoluments so calculated subject to proportional reduction where qualifying service was less than 33 years.

4.- No arrears on account of revision of pension, including Travel Concession, due to notional fixation of pay (pertaining to pre- 1.1.86 period) will be admissible for the period prior to 1.1.1996.

5.- No Commutation will be admissible for the additional amount of pension occurring as a result of this revision. The existing commuted portion, if any would continue to be deducted from the consolidated pension while making monthly disbursements.



Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Government of Punjab-revised rates effective from 1st January, 2003.

Madam,

I am directed to invite a reference to this Deptt. Letter No. 1/29/98-3FPFC/9621 dt. 23.12.2002 sanctioning the instalment of dearness relief admissible from 1st July, 2002 and to say that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to revise the rate of dearness relief to Pensioners/Family Pensioners/Extraordinary Pensioners etc. of the Government of Punjab from 52% to 55% w.e.f. 1st Jan. 03 to compensate them for the rise of cost of living beyond average Consumer Price Index 306.33 (as on 1st January, 1996).

- 1.2 Payment of Dearness Relief involving fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 1.3 Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners etc. such as regulation of Dearness Relief during employment/re-employment and regulation of Dearness Relief where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.
- 1.4 On the analogy of decision taken by Govt. of India it has been decided to dispense with the issue of ready reckoner alongwith the Dearness Relief Orders. It will now be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority including the rationalised banks etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.
- 1.5 All District Treasury Officers/Treasury Officers and Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to pensioners/Family Pensioners etc. on the basis of these orders immediately.
- 1.6 The expenditure involved will be debited to the Head "2071-Pension and Other Retirement Benefits."
- 1.7 The liability in respect of pre-1st Nov. 1966 service of the pensioners and their family pensioners shall be divisible amongst the successor States of the erstwhile State of Punjab i.e. P.b., Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Union Territory, Chd. in terms of the 14th Schedule of P.b. Re-organisation Act, 1966.

Sub: Induction Level Post for grant of time bound promotional scales to Board Employees.

The PSEB having been seized of the problem of stagnation prevailing amongst the various cadres of regular employees and its consequent effect on their efficiency, it was felt that an employee under ideal service conditions get normally two promotions from his initial recruitment level during his service. As a step to this direction, the Board vide O/O No.197/Fin./PRC-1988 dt.23.4.90 decided to introduce a scheme to allow time bound promotional scales to its employees after completion of 9/16 years regular service. This scheme contains the following provisions relevant to determine the induction level posts for the purpose of grant of TBPSs:-

"Feature-2: For granting the time bound promotional/devised promotional scale to each employee in any cadre, the prescribed period will be counted from the date of commencement of service in the lowest post on which regular appointment has been made through direct recruitment in the concerned cadre."

"Feature-4: If an employee already in the service of the Board, is directly appointed to a higher post through open selection then for the purpose of grant of time bound promotional/devised promotional scale in that cadre, counting of the period of service will commence from the date of joining the above post by direct recruitment."

2. However, on persistent demands from various Unions/Associations, exceptions to the above policy were made in case of certain categories such as UDC, Divisional Accountant/Revenue Accountant, Jr. Engineer/SSO, Thermal Categories such as Jr. Specialist, Boiler Controller, Desk Controller, Turbo Generator Controller, Shift Chemist and Junior Training Officer, Statistical Officer, Foreman Spl., Sr. Industrial Relations Officer, Assistant Engineer, Jr. Scale Stenographer etc. Still there have been representations for bringing change in the induction level posts such as from LDC to UDC (after having qualified Departmental Accounts Examination) and from UDC to LDC treating their combined service as LDC and UDC. In case of Divisional Accountants, who were initially appointed either as LDCs/UDCs or Steno-Typists and had already availed the benefit of Ist. TBPS, for allowing to have the induction level as Divisional Accountant. Similarly some other categories which are alleged to have been under employed as Asstt. Line Man/Oiler & Cleaner/Telephone Attendant & Lab. Attendant requested for allowing to have the induction level as Lineman/Sub Stn. Attendant/Test Mech./Telephone Mech. and still further also said to have been under employed Diploma Holders - Test Mech./Telephone Mech. requested to allow to have the induction level as Junior Engineer.

3. The Board while considering such proposals as above, decided that the proposals regarding induction posts be re-examined for all categories expressing the view that prima-facie the concept of induction post means the post, which an employee joins at the time of entering into the service of the Board or after any specific examination is conducted for recruitment from within the Board.

4. Accordingly, the whole issue has been reconsidered by the Board based on its in-depth re-examination carried out at a sufficiently higher level and it has been decided that the

induction level even in the case of categories where the recruitment is from within the Board as referred to in Feature-4 of O/O No.197/Fin./PRC-1988 dt.23.4.90 or in the case of Assistant Engineers (Elect./Civil) who are promoted as such from departmental employees (Technical Subordinates and Drawing Staff) as per quota provided for AMIE/Degree Holders in accordance with Regulation 10.7 of PSEB Service of Engineers (Electrical) Regulations-1965 and Regulation 10.4 of PSEB Service of Engineers (Civil) Regulations-1965 referred to in O/O.No.205/Fin./PRC-1988 dt.24.5.90, should be the level of their direct recruitment/promotion deem to be as direct recruitment and this should be made clear in the offer of appointment/promotion order. In such cases since there are two different induction levels for the grant of TBPS, therefore, such employees should be given option to elect the induction level between the two either that of the lower post or that of the post to which recruited/promoted. In case where the benefit of grant of TBPSs is already availed by an employee before recruitment/promotion as above, if an employee opts for keeping the induction level of higher post, he will have to surrender the benefit of first TBPS already availed in the lower post. Otherwise, he can be allowed second TBPS of the same (lower induction post) on completion of 16 years service to be counted from the date of joining on the lower post.

5. In view of the above, the existing provisions of feature No.4 in O/O No.197 dt.23.4.90 shall stand amended to the above extent. There shall be no different induction levels/ Categorisation for the grant of TBPSs. This decision shall be applicable prospectively and resultantly the deviations already made in changing induction levels will be treated as redundant for future application.


Subject: Fixation of pay on promotion of the employees promoted upto 27.5.03 and subsequently.

Reference this office order No. 425/PRC-1988-1/L-V/Vol.2 dated 28.5.03, vide which second proviso to Reg.-8 in the PSEB(Revised Pay)Regulations-1988 was deleted. In this regard a question has arisen as to how the pay of an employee who was promoted before 28.5.2003 and who had exercised option to have his pay fixed under proviso(b) to Rule-8 before that date should be fixed;

The position is clarified as under:-

1. In case of promotion of an employee before 28.5.2003, where the option under Proviso(b) has been exercised before 28.5.03 and his pay was fixed by allowing one increment from the date of promotion, his pay on the date of next increment shall be fixed as per his entitlement by virtue of the option already exercised.
2. Where an employee was promoted before 28.5.03 but had not exercised the option to have his pay fixed under proviso(b) his pay shall be fixed as per the changed position of Rule-8 after deletion of proviso(b);
3. Marginal cases, where the promotion had taken effect before 28.5.03 and the employee had


exercised option to have his pay fixed under proviso(b) the pay had not been fixed till 23.5.2003, the case may be referred to the Finance Section giving reasons for delay in fixation of pay for decision."
