Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Government of Punjab - Revised rates effective from 1st July, 2006.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Department Letter No. 1/29/98-3FPCC/2800, dated the 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2006 on the subject cited above and to say that the Governor of Punjab is pleased to decide that the dearness relief payable to Punjab Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners/Extraordinary Pensioners etc. shall be enhanced from existing rate of 24% to 29% with effect from 1st July, 2006 to compensate them for the rise of cost of living.

1.2 Payment of dearness Relief involving fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee if the same is 50 paise or above conversely, it will be rounded off to the lower side if the same is less than 50 paise.

1.3 Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief to Pensioners etc. such as regulation of Dearness Relief during employment/re-employment and regulation of Dearness Relief where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.

1.4 On the analogy of decision taken by the Government of India, it has been decided to dispense with the issue of ready reckoner along with the Dearness Relief Orders. It will now be the responsibility of Pension Disbursing Authority, including the nationalized banks etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.

1.5 All District Treasury Officers/Treasury Officers and Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to Pensioners/Family Pensioners etc. on the basis of these orders immediately.

2. The expenditure involved will be debited to the head "2071-Pension and Other Retirement Benefits."

3. The liability in respect of pre 1st. November, 1966 service of the pensioners and their family pensioners shall be divisible amongst the successor States of the erstwhile State of Punjab i.e. Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Union Territory, Chandigarh, in Terms of the 14<sup>th</sup> Schedule of Punjab Reorganization Act, 1966.

I am directed to invite a reference to the subject cited above and to state that the entire matter regarding the revision of present table of commutation of pension has been engaging the attention of the State Government for some time past. The Governor of Punjab is pleased to reduce the discount rate from existing 8% to 4.75% and revise the existing table (copy enclosed) for the calculation of commutation of pension in place of the present table incorporated as Annexure to Chapter XI of Punjab C.S.R. Vol. II. This revised table supersedes the existing table and shall apply to all cases of retirement arising on or after 31.10.2006.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Punjab Government letter No. 4/19/97-FP1/429, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January 1998 and to say that the demand of various associations of the employees for revision of rate of House Rent Allowance in respect of employees posted at Bhatinda city has been under the consideration of the State Government for some time past. The city of Bhatinda is presently classified as 'C' Class City for the purpose of House Rent Allowance and the same is admissible to employees @ 7-1/2% of basic pay.

Keeping in view the population of Bhatinda city, Municipal Corporation has been sent up w.e.f. 10.4.2003. On the analogy of other Municipal Corporations, it has been decided to place the city of Bhatinda in the list of B-2 class cities instead of 'C' class for the purpose of entitlement of House Rent Allowance.

These orders shall take effect with immediate effect. The list given in the letter dated 22.1.98 referred to above shall be deemed to have been amended accordingly.
